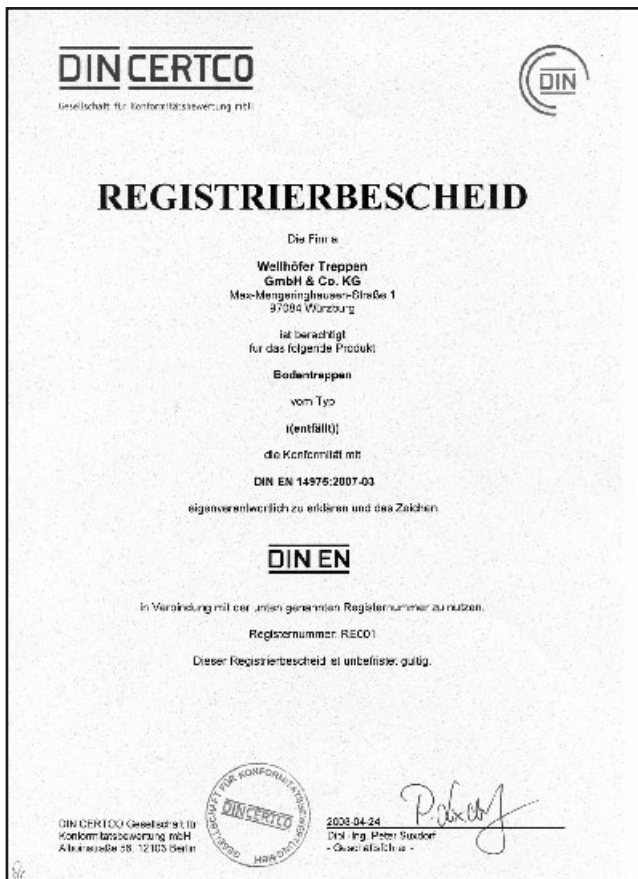

### What do you need to know?

"Attic stairs according to EN 14975 do **not** fall under the construction products guideline and/or Construction Products Regulation, and therefore **no** CE mark based on a declaration of performance is needed."

This is quoted from the definitive statement from the German Institute for Building Technology (Deutsches Institut für Bautechnik, DIBt; responsible for national and European approvals). In response to our request, we were referred to this statement by the Federal Institute for Materials Research and Testing (Bundesanstalt für Materialforschung und -prüfung, BAM, responsible in Germany for product information of this kind). The justification given is that EN 14975 for attic stairs - as is also currently the case with standards for interior doors, for example - is "not a harmonised standard".
